2019 Referee Training

If you love soccer, consider becoming a referee. It's a great way to learn more about the game and earn spending money. The minimum age for a Hillwood referee is 11 and referees can earn \$20/game.

During the summer, youth refs ages 13+ can sideline referee youth tournaments (multiple games in one day) and make some good money on the weekend.

What: Referee training Referee training clinics run throughout the spring/summer and are scheduled in the evenings and/or on weekends for eight hours. It's requires registration and costs between \$45.00 and \$65.00 depending on the class location and an 80% or better score to pass. Where: Anywhere Registration starts at <https://www.wareferees.org> On the right hand side, look for "How to Become a Referee". New, young referees want to register for the Grade 9 or 8 clinics (ranking is in descending order).

For current referees who want to recertify at Grade 8 or upgrade to Grade 7, check the clinics SOON! Classes are coming up quickly.
